Ultimately, the tour can be to any destination along the route for any duration you wish to stay, as long as we remain within the 1.5-day (Approximately 15 hours of sightseeing within the vehicle) time frame. However, we have thoughtfully planned itineraries that eliminate the need for excessive planning, thereby enhancing your enjoyment. Most stops will include excellent photo opportunities.

The highlight of embarking on a 1.5-day tour is that it offers the opportunity to enjoy either a sunset, a sunrise, or both in unique locations. Just mention it, and we'll organise it!

- **Personalised pickup from your Melbourne CBD address**
- **Stop 1: Torquay**, home of the surf capital of Australia.
- **Stop 2: Bells Beach**, renowned globally as a premier surf break on the ASP Tour.
- *Drive Past: Southside Beach Bells*
- *Drive Past: Point Addis, Marine National Park*
- **Stop 3: Anglesea** offers an opportunity to visit the 'Chocolaterie' or go kangaroo spotting at the Anglesea Golf Course.
- *Drive Past: Aireys Inlet Split Point Lighthouse, Fairhaven 'Pole House'*
- **Stop 4: Eastern View**, Famous Great Ocean Road Sign
- *Drive past Thirteenth Beach, a 4.5 km stretch of surf breaks, sand, and picturesque coastline. You may even spot racehorses having a training session in the water. It's also home to a couple of Victoria's finest golf courses.*
- **Stop 5: Barwon Heads.** Browse the shops or take a coffee/lunch break at the renowned 'The Heads' restaurant, which is perched over the Barwon River. A quick visit to The Bluff Lookout.
- *Drive Past: Ocean Grove*, leisurely drive offers a fair chance of spotting a koala or two, along with other iconic Australian wildlife.

- **Stop 6: Point Lonsdale.** Take in the views of both sides of this seaside village: the rugged coast of the ocean side and the calmness of the sheltered waters on the protected marine park foreshore.
- **Stop 8: Queenscliff** – A historic seaside village at the entrance to Port Phillip Bay. It features historical Victorian-era buildings and houses, art galleries, and many charming dining spots.
- *Car ferry trip from Queenscliff to Sorrento (40 mins)*
- **Stop 9: Point Nepean National Park** is home to the historical Quarantine Station & Fort Nepean, along with numerous other heritage buildings, lush walking tracks, and opportunities to spot local wildlife. The park offers stunning coastal views and the chance to ride an e-bike to cover the vast area and see all the sights.
- **Stop 10: Overnight Stay – Sorrento**

- *Drive past Portsea Back Beach to enjoy* views of the long stretch of sand facing Bass Strait. This spot can bring in some big surf waves and is a very popular destination during the summer months.
- **Stop 11: Arthur's Seat State Park** is the highest viewpoint on the Mornington Peninsula, and on a clear day, it offers stunning views across the bay and back towards The Bellarine, stretching all the way to Melbourne. There's an opportunity to hop on the 'Eagle Cable Car' for a one-way or return trip in private gondolas.
- **Stop 12: Red Hill** — Grab a coffee or brunch at one of the local premium cafes before heading back into town.
- **Return to Melbourne CBD Address.**

Below are some suggested additional activities you can enjoy at specific destinations; however, this is not exhaustive. A price estimate is also provided; however, since seasons impact opening times, menu changes, and offerings, we need to quote individually based on your preferences. Additional experiences may increase the overall tour time; however, skipping or shortening other destination stops can be adjusted to suit.

Torquay

Surf shops abound; if you enjoy surfing or the brands, this place is the mecca of surf apparel. It includes Rip Curl, Quiksilver, and similar brands.

Anyone up for a private surf lesson? 'Go Ride a Wave' is a professional outfit, offering services along the Southwest Coast. (\$220 pp)

Aireys Inlet

Lunch at Aireys Inlet Hotel, soaking up the views, or at A La Greque for an afternoon of fresh Greek cuisine. (\$100 pp)

Lorne

Lunch at Totties offers Italian fine dining at The Lorne Hotel, a drink at the Grand Pacific Hotel (Circa 1879) overlooking Lorne township and its iconic beach (\$100-\$200pp).

Or a gourmet Aussie BBQ provided by **Luxe Ventures** at Scotchman's Hill, with views of Louttit Bay and Lorne Point.(\$50 pp)

For the more adventurous, Live Wire Park is home to Australia's most extreme zip line experience, or you can challenge yourself on the treetop canopy circuit. (\$130 pp) Great fun if travelling with children. A short drive further out to the back of Lorne township takes us to Erskine Waterfalls (no fee).

Great Ocean Road Coast

Premium accommodation is abundant if you have more time and wish to immerse yourself in these charming seaside towns. Please don't hesitate to let us customise your tour to include an overnight stay, which will allow you to see and enjoy more of what the coast has to offer.

Bellarine Peninsula
